# The Charter

We, the undersigned organisations, through this Charter commit ourselves to the Tanzania Climate-Smart Agriculture Alliance (TCSAA) hereafter “the Alliance”. The Alliance shall serve as a platform for the promotion of Climate Smart Agriculture (CSA) across United Republic of Tanzania (Mainland and Zanzibar), while creating a national and broad-based forum on CSA in Tanzania through effective linkages with key CSA initiatives at the Africa and Global level specifically, with the Africa Climate Smart Agriculture Alliance (ACSAA) and the Global Alliance for Climate Smart Agriculture (GACSA).

The TCSAA composed of state and non-state institutions including local, national, regional and international non-governmental Organisations based in Tanzania and committed to a climate-resilient agricultural sector that supports Inclusive Economy for sustainable livelihoods and ecosystems.

We are convinced that effective coordination and promotion of CSA initiatives will increase the uptake of CSA technologies and practices, increase CSA knowledge, research and innovation; strengthen and where possible, create partnerships and synergies in CSA approaches in Tanzania.


We, the signatories to this Charter therefore agree to:

- promote resilient and inclusive agriculture in Tanzania;
- be an inclusive platform for all institutions promoting CSA and sustainable food production and ecosystems in Tanzania;
- be an open platform for knowledge and best practice exchange;
- equal rights of member organisations to participate in deliberations and activities of the Alliance;
- employ gender responsive approaches in all its activities;
- support resource mobilization for the sustainability of the Alliance;
- abide by national financial regulations and laws governing such organisations in Tanzania;

Amendments to this Charter shall be made by the TCSAA National Annual Forum (NAF). Any matters not covered by this Charter shall be specified in the TCSAA Blueprint as well as any other rules as may be adopted by the NAF. The TCSAA Blueprint and such other rules adopted by NAF shall be read together with the Charter.
